UNIFORM POLICY

Our Governing Board has voted that all students at the Russell School wear uniforms. This is a mandatory policy, and is not optional. If you are unable to afford a uniform please reach out to us so we can be of assistance.

BOYS

Should wear khaki colored pants or khaki shorts in warm weather with a Russell School uniform colored shirt (hunter green with school logo). Hoodies, jackets and other outerwear is also available for colder weather.

GIRLS

Should wear Khaki colored pants or skirt or khaki shorts in warm weather with a Russell School uniform colored shirt (hunter green with school logo). Hoodies, jackets and other outerwear is also available for colder weather.

MOVEMENT OR PHYSICAL EDUCATION

On days where students are participating in classes that require a lot of movement, students may wear solid green or black sweatpants or shorts.

DOLLAR DAYS

On Fridays, students are permitted to go uniform free for \$1 and may either wear reasonable casual attire or participate in the theme dress day. Proceeds from Dollar Days help support our student activities such as Field Day!
